Subject: Cracked Condensate Drain Pans YP9C, YM9M, TG9S & GG9S

We have received a few reports of condensate drain pans cracking on the new 33" condensing furnaces.

Extensive investigation has found the problem to be linked to a lubricant used during the expansion process of the secondary heat exchanger tubes. When a high amount of this lubricant is present in the weld seam of the condensate pan, a stress crack can occur in a short period of time. The lubricant involved was new to the 33" furnace and used in the manufacturing process from initial production through 9/20/08.

On 9/21/08, the lubricant was changed back to the original lubricant (used on the 40" furnace), which is completely compatible with the condensate pan material.

Upon initial furnace start up, the warm, mildly acidic condensate dilutes any water-based lubricant and removes any residue from the inside of the condensate pan. Once the oil residue has been flushed out, a crack will not initiate or propagate in the condensate pan. If the furnace has been in heating operation and the pan has not developed a crack, no action is required.

Cracked drain pans will begin to leak noticeably within 1 minute after water begins flowing out of the condensate drain hose. If a leak is identified, then the condensate pan should be replaced per the instructions included with the Source 1 kit. If there is no evidence of a leak, allow the unit to run for at least 10 minutes after the trap is full to flush out any residual oil, thereby preventing a crack from developing.

It is recommended that installing dealers have a supply of each of the six sizes of drain pans on their truck to insure a rapid condensate pan change, if needed. The standard DOA warranty labor rate applies. Bulk pack kits of each pan size are available for order from Source1

In the event of a service call after installation and start up, this YS letter will provide a new drain pan and a 1.5 hour credit at the dealer's registered DOA labor rate for replacement of a cracked drain pan.

For units in distributor inventory, this YS letter will allow for inspection of units for condensate pan cracks and replacement of pans as required. The drain pan and a fair and reasonable allowance for the replacement will be provided.
